# **JEAN-LUC PEPIN RESEARCH CHAIR**

The Faculty of Social Sciences is seeking candidates for the Jean-Luc Pepin Research Chair. The Jean-Luc Pepin Chair was established at the University of Ottawa in 2001 and honors the memory of Jean-Luc Pepin, who was a man of action, a political thinker, and former federal cabinet minister and co-chair of the Pepin-Robarts Commission.

### PURPOSE OF THE CHAIR

The purpose of the Jean-Luc Pepin Research Chair is to:

- · conduct research on Canadian politics;
- actively disseminating the research findings;
- develop links with government departments and organizations at the provincial, federal and international levels;
- promote the activities of the Chair.

# **DURATION OF THE MANDATE**

July 1, 2018 to June 30, 2021, may be renewed for 2 additional years upon evaluation.

### **DUTIES**

- Research and publish in relevant areas.
- Host an annual public conference on a topic related to the chair.
- Hold seminars related to the themes of the chair.
- Promote the chair as a center of excellence for research and dissemination on Canadian politics.
- Supervise and mentor graduate students.
- Participate in academic and administrative activities in the University.
- Establish strategic links between the University and government departments and organizations at the provincial, federal and international levels.
- Engage in fundraising activities for the chair.
- Carry out other activities as specified in the collective agreement.

## REPORTING AND ACCOUNTABILITY

The chairholder will be expected to report annually in writing to the Vice-Dean, Research and to the Dean. The annual report will cover activities from July 1<sup>st</sup> to June 30<sup>th</sup> of the previous year and should be submitted by August 31<sup>st</sup> of each year.

## RESEARCH FUNDS

The chairholder will receive \$50,000 annually to finance the activities of the chair, \$25,000 of which can be used to buy-out a course as per the Faculty of Social Sciences policy.



# **ELIGIBILITY**

- The applicant holds a full time tenure or tenure-track faculty position in the Faculty of Social Sciences.
- The applicant holds the rank of Associate or Full Professor.
- The applicant has a strong track record in research, teaching, and dissemination
- The applicant does not currently hold a Research Chair.

# **SELECTION CRITERIA**

- The ability to accomplish the duties of the chair.
- A file that reflects a solid understanding of Canadian politics.
- The quality and demonstrated excellence of the candidate's research.
- Teaching excellence.
- Contributions to the academic life of the University.

- A research plan demonstrating a strong commitment for research excellence in Canadian politics.
